CH.1-6 The *gracious words, comforting words,* Are the 8-Night Visions

Vision One: Horses among Myrtle Trees (Zechariah 1:7-17

The Source of Their Discouragement- The LORD is angry and has abandoned us.

Yahweh's Answer. - He was standing among the myrtle trees at the bottom, bringing His Mercy and His Grace!

I will return to Jerusalem **with mercy**, My house will be built in it," declares the LORD of hosts, "and a measuring line will be stretched over Jerusalem."

Vision Two: Four Horns and Four Carpenters (Zechariah 1:18-21)

The Source Of Their Discouragement – Gentile powers are crushing us.

Yahweh's Answer –I have perfectly crafted solutions!

Vision Three: A Man Measuring Jerusalem (Zech 2:1-13)

The Source of Their Discouragement- Limiting Yahweh to old human measurements.

Yahweh's Answer- exchange your old measuring line for New His Measuring Line. Which is The LORD Himself. ⁵ For I,' declares the LORD, 'will be a wall of fire [a] around her, and I will be the glory in her midst."

Vision Four. Joshua, the high priest, standing accused before the Judge of Heaven and Earth (Zechariah 3)

The Source Of Their Discouragement - We are unclean and have no standing before The Judge on His Throne.

Yahweh's Answer: I have chosen you, pulled you out of the fire, and cleansed you from sin, both its guilt and its power.

Vision Five- a solid gold lampstand with a bowl at the top and seven lamps on it

The Source Of Their Discouragement- Our testimony and labors have produced no fruit and utterly fail to glorify God's Dwelling Presence among us.

Yahweh's Answer- 'Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit,' says the LORD Almighty.

Visions 6 & 7

5 Then I lifted up my eyes again and looked, and behold, there was a flying scroll. ² And he said to me, "What do you see?" And I answered, "I see a flying scroll; its length is twenty [a]cubits and its width ten cubits." ³ Then he said to me, "This is the curse that is going forth over the face of the whole [b]land; surely everyone who steals will be purged away according to [a]the writing on one side, and everyone who swears

will be purged away according to [d] the writing on the other side. 4 I will make it go forth," declares the LORD of hosts, "and it will enter the house of the thief and the house of the one who swears falsely by My name; and it will spend the night within that house and consume it with its timber and stones."5 Then the angel who was speaking with me went out and said to me, "Lift up now your eyes and see what this is going forth." 6 I said, "What is it?" Visions 6&7 address the most profound and most inexorable source of discouragement plaguing God's People.

This reality in the hearts of His Remnant is revealed in Ch. 1

11 So they answered the angel of the LORD who was standing among the myrtle trees and said, "We have [b]patrolled the earth, and behold, all the earth is [c]peaceful and quiet."

This is not encouraging news for the remnant. This is devastating.

12 Then the angel of the LORD said, "O LORD of hosts, how long will You have no compassion for Jerusalem and the cities of Judah, with which You have been indignant these seventy years?" 13 The LORD answered the angel who was speaking with me with [d]gracious words, comforting words.

curse, as it is written: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law." [e] 11 Clearly no one who relies on the law is justified before God, because "the righteous will live by faith." [f] 12 The law is not based on faith; on the contrary, it says, "The person who does these things will live by them." [g] 13 Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.

strongs -nâqâh, naw-kaw'; a primitive root-unpunished (11x), acquit (2x)

- 1. to hold innocent, acquit
- 2. to leave unpunished

Nothing is hidden from God's Righteous Judgments, and nothing goes unpunished.

In God's House, the punishment fell on the Son.

In a man's house, the punishment consumes it.

Not only is every sin measured, but humanity's love of sinning is constrained.

2 Thes. 2:7"He who constrains is taken out of the way"

a phrase from the Bible, specifically, which refers to the idea that a powerful force currently holding back evil and lawlessness will eventually be removed, allowing wickedness to fully manifest itself; often interpreted as the Holy Spirit's restraining influence before the end times. (got questions)

Exalting wickedness?

Rom. 1: ²⁸ And just as they did not see fit [4] to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper, ²⁹ being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips, ³⁰ slanderers, [4] haters of God, insolent, arrogant, boastful, inventors of evil, disobedient to parents, ³¹ without understanding, untrustworthy, unloving, unmerciful; ³² and although they know the ordinance of God, that those who practice such things are worthy of death, they not only do the same, but also give hearty approval to those who practice them.

The Church And Wickedness

1 Cor. 5^9 I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people— 10 not at all meaning the people of this world who are immoral, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters. In that case you would have to leave this world. 11 But now I am writing to you that you must not associate with anyone who claims to be a brother or sister but is sexually immoral or greedy, an idolater or slanderer, a drunkard or swindler. Do not even eat with such people.

¹² What business is it of mine to judge those outside the church? Are you not to judge those inside? ¹³ God will judge those outside. "Expel the wicked person from among you."

The Holy Spirit inspired writers to use the word *ekklesia* because it unmistakably means the Church is a body of individuals who have been called out, called forth, and separated for the purposes of God. (Rick Renner)

2 Cor. 6: 17 Therefore, "Come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you."

Rev. 18:4 "Come out of her, (Babylon)my people, so that you will not participate in her sins and receive of her plagues; ⁵ for her sins have [h] piled up as high as heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities.

Rev. 22: 10 And he *said to me, "Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, for the time is near. 11 Let the one who does wrong, still do wrong; and the one who is filthy, still be filthy; and let the one who is righteous, still practice righteousness; and the one who is holy, still keep himself holy."

The Godly response to evil is

Rom.:12. ¹⁷ Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. ¹⁸ If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. ¹⁹ Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, for it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," [d] says the Lord. ²⁰ On the contrary:

"If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink.
In doing this, you will heap burning coals on his head."[9]

21 Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
